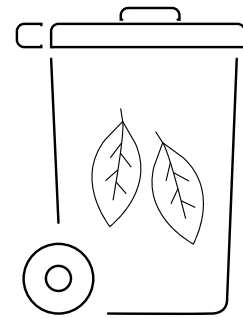

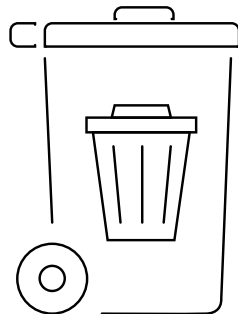

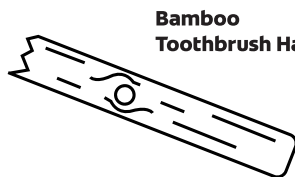
Green Waste Bin



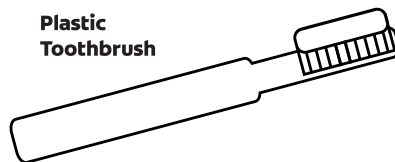
Bamboo Toothbrush Head



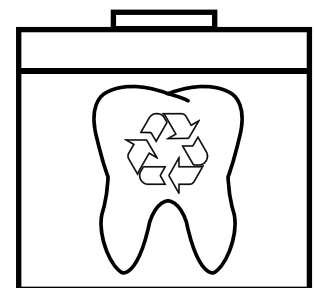

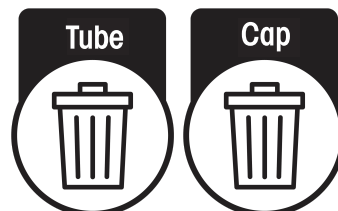
Bamboo Toothbrush Handle

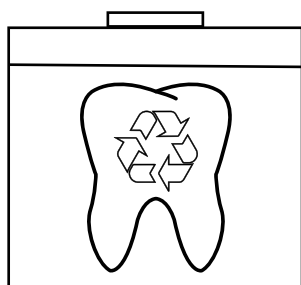
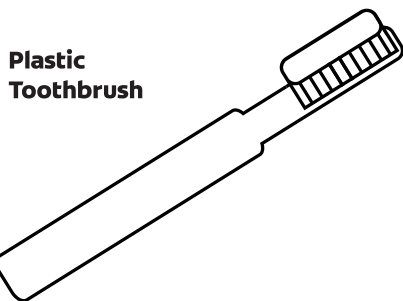


Look out for Colgate Recyclable Tubes! Some toothpaste tubes now have the ARL on it which says the tubes can now be recycled. Remember to remove the cap and place it in the bin.

Be sure to check with your local council first to ensure that these materials are accepted in your home recycling bin.

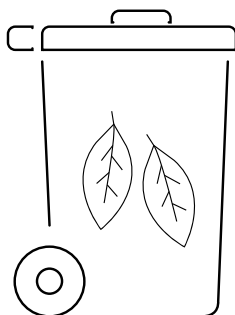
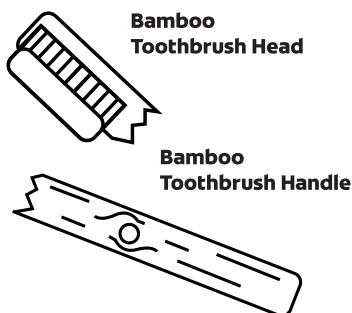


Other toothpaste tubes will **not** have the ARL or an ARL that says items cannot be recycled at home. They can be taken to Oral Care Recycling Boxes or must be put in the rubbish bin.



Items that cannot be recycled at home can be recycled at oral care recycling boxes in dental clinics or special drop off points.

Accepted items include; toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes, dental floss containers, and electric toothbrush heads.



Bamboo Brushes cannot be recycled but can be placed in your garden waste bin, provided they do not have plastic or paint coatings.

Snap the head off the brush and place in the rubbish bin. Then put the handle in your council collected garden waste bin, ready for municipal mulching.
