

Processing and recycling your used printer cartridges



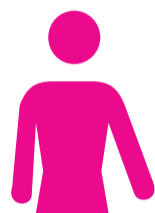
Cartridges can be returned for recycling through all Officeworks and Office National outlets, and at participating Australia Post, Harvey Norman, JB Hi-Fi and The Good Guys stores. Your workplace can apply for a free collection box if you use more than 3 cartridges a month.



Close the Loop



When collected from your local 'Cartridges 4 Planet Ark' box, the cartridges sorted at the Close the Loop facility in Melbourne



Cartridges are manually sorted.

Some cartridges are returned to their original manufacturers for reuse or recycling.



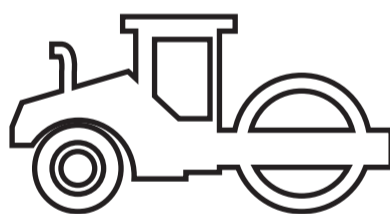
Cartridges are crushed and the materials separated.

Eddy current removes aluminium



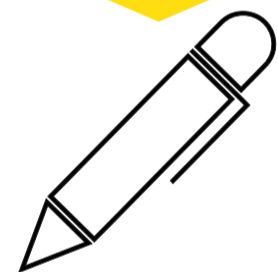
Becomes cans and other items

Residual toner



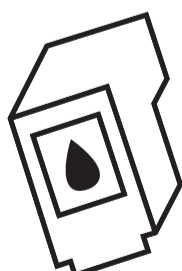
Used in TonerPave™ and TonerPlas™ asphalt

Residual ink



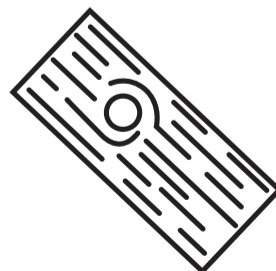
Made into 90% recycled Enviroliner pens and Lousy Ink recycled artist ink

Clean Plastics



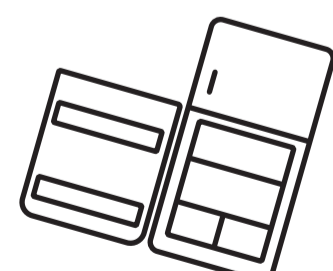
Becomes pens, new cartridges, and other plastic products
